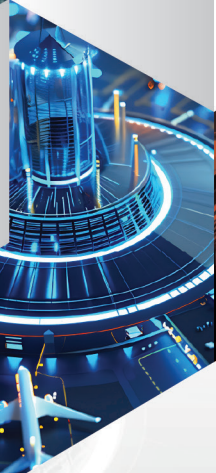

Background
